
Law 42.11 – Damage to the pitch; area to be protected

The whole <u>Pitch</u> including the <u>Protected area</u> must be protected at all times This applies to both turf & artificial pitches



Law 42.12 - Bowler running on to the <u>Protected area</u> after delivering the ball This is an individual offence

If a bowler offends, he is given a **First caution**

If a bowler re-offends in that innings he receives a **Final warning**

If a bowler further offends in that innings he must be replaced by another bowler

The offender may not bowl again in that innings

The offence is reported to the Governing body who may act against the offender The bowler changing ends does not negate these provisions

Law 42.13 – Fielder causing avoidable damage to any part of the pitch

This is a team offence

If any fielder offends, he & his captain are given a First caution

If any fielder offends in that innings he & his captain are given a Final warning

If <u>any fielder</u> further offends in that innings **5 Penalty runs** are awarded to the Batting side

The offence must be reported to the Governing body who may act against the offender/s

Law 42.14 - Batsman causing avoidable damage to any part of the pitch

This is a team offence

If <u>any batsman</u> offends, both batsmen & each incoming batsman are given a **First caution**If <u>any batsman</u> re-offends, both batsmen & each incoming batsman are given a **Final warning**If <u>any batsman</u> further offends in that innings **5 Penalty runs are awarded to the Fielding side**The offence must be reported to the Governing body who may act against the offender/s
